As promotional secretary I recommend the following:

 That the promotional secretary be included in the State Association planning meeting with voting privileges in matters concerning the State Association meeting arrangements.

HOME MISSIONS BOARD REPORT

 We recommend Brother Willis Osborne to be hired by the Home Missions Board of the Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists as an Associate Missionary to build a new Free Will Baptist Church in Abingdon, VA.

- We recommend that the proposed budget for this work be adopted and funded by the Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists. This budget includes:
 - a. \$12,000.00 for items needed to begin.
 - b. \$2,240.04/month to meet regular monthly expenses including salary and church payment on \$65,000.00 note borrowed from the National Association Home Missions Department.
- We recommend that this be a joint project with the National Association of Free Will Baptists.
- 4. We recommend that every FWB church in Virginia support this new work in four ways:
 - a. Receive a special offering for this work to help purchase those items needed to begin this church.
 - Encourage each member of our churches to sign faith pledge cards for a period of two years.
 - Place this work in the church budget with the understanding that this will be brought to self supporting status as quickly as the Lord permits.
 - d. Allow Brother Willis Osborne personally to share his burden with your people.
- 5. We recommend that the expenses of the Virginia State Home Missions Board members as they carry on their work be paid from the general fund of the State Home Mission Board. This includes but is not limited to mileage at the standard IRS rate, meals, and long distance phone expenses.

Note: Money can be mailed to either Walter Statzer, the Virginia State Home Missions Board treasurer, or the National Home Missions office in Nashville designed to the Willis Oshorne account.
