REPORT OF THE PROMOTIONAL DIRECTOR 80TH ANNUAL VIRGINIA STATE ASSOCIATION MEETING JUNE 15, 2018

OUR FIFTH FULL-TIME YEAR, A MILESTONE

The milestone for the promotional office for the 2017-2018 fiscal year is that all funds raised were generated directly through support for the work of the promotional office within Virginia and the work of Grace Mission outside Virginia. As noted in the financial report, Grace Mission contributed 35% to fully fund the promotional director's salary as adopted by the state association. We budgeted \$20,000.00 for this purpose; however, an additional \$5,000.00 was needed.

Funding through associations is a little lower than expected as well as individual donors, but church budget support for the office increased to its highest level again this year. We expect some fluctuation in individual donor amounts; even so, the rise in church budget support is encouraging.

Although Grace Mission has helped a great deal, Virginia support still needs to increase so more funds raised through Grace Mission can be directed to its missionary purpose.

WORK OF THE PROMOTIONAL OFFICE AND GRACE MISSION

Our work on behalf of our state association, local associations, churches, and pastors is running smoothly and effectively. I realize more and more the confidence that is being placed in this office to care for and minister to our various needs. It is certainly a privilege to serve our brethren across our state association and now helping make an impact for Christ beyond our borders. I believe we are now more than ever meeting our adopted state motto, "Churches of the Commonwealth Ministering to the World."

We are thankful for the support of Dr. David Crowe and FWB North American Ministries for Grace Mission and the financial stability their help is making for this growing work. We are also grateful for the special grant of \$25,000 provided to Grace Mission this year through David Brown and the FWB Foundation. These are the beginning funds to help us in our development of the GRACE Outreach software. Once developed, this software will be of benefit to all of our churches statewide but also become a significant funding resource for Grace Mission outside our state. We are also thankful for the cooperative work we have now with Randall House Publications and Ron Hunter. On June 3rd with the new Sunday School quarter, Grace Mission began live-streaming the Adult Instruction of the D6 Curriculum. These lessons are being taught weekly by Pastor Jay Baines right here in Virginia. We are now preparing to provide the Teen Instruction of the D6 Curriculum as well. A special thanks go to David Womack for his working closely with me in this endeavor.

For this upcoming year, the promotional office will serve as the CTS Representative by means of promoting, encouraging, and coordinating participation. We have not had much participation throughout Virginia in the past, and we hope that this approach will motivate greater involvement. If any church wishes to become involved or parents of youth want their children to participate, please contact the promotional office. We will help provide all the information you might need or lead you to the specific helps you need to get started. For competition in 2019, individuals and churches need to consider getting the needed information now.

I also want to thank our treasurer, Brent Patrick, and Gateway's finance manager, Belinda Lupton, for their tireless work this past year in putting together our financial books for the state, promotional office, and Grace Mission. They were both so gracious to respond to our needs and desires for reporting. In conclusion, I cannot help but thank all of you, our churches and associations for supporting this office. Thank you for the privilege of being your servant! Please stand with us as we stand up for you.
