54TH SESSION PROCEEDINGS

The 54th session of the Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists convened at the First Free Will Baptist Church of Roanoke on Thursday evening, June 18, 1992, at 7:30 p.m.

The session was opened by singing "Love Lifted Me."

Prayer was led by Bill Fulcher. Welcome was extended by the host pastor, Jeff Crabtree. Response was given by the clerk, Walter Stutzer, who then introduced the officers, concluding with the Moderator, Daniel Merkh. Brother Merkh then called the meeting to order and proceeded with the business.

The following committees were appointed by the Moderator:

Nominating Committee: Richard Barnes (Chairman), Sherman Grace, Willis Osborne.

Registration Committee: Kyle Sexton (Chairman), Steven Faherty, Daryle Hurd.

Credentials Committee: Gaye Sutton (Chairperson), Glenna Slemp, Sophie Darnell.

The Worship service was opened with the congregation singing "Since Jesus Came Into My Heart." Prayer was led by Howard Pittman. Earl and Gaye Sutton offered our special music by singing "Nailing My Sins To His Cross." Willis Osborne brought an inspiring message on the "Immediate results of His coming" using scriptures from Revelation 19:7-9. "I Surrender All" was sung during the invitation.

An offering of \$49.37 was received. The service was dismissed by Daniel Merkh.

The Friday morning session was opened by singing "Down At The Cross." Prayer was offered by Earl Sutton. Gary Rowlette conducted devotions by reading from Second Peter 3:10-14, using as a thought, "What kind of people should we be?"

Glen Johnson was appointed by the Moderator to serve as Assistant Moderator for this meeting in the absence of the elected Assistant Moderator. The minutes of 1992 session were read for information.

The report from the Credentials Committee was received and approved. All Associations (5) belonging to the Virginia State Association reported. Delegates were seated by the Moderator.

Friday worship service began with the congregation singing "In The Sweet By And By." Prayer was led by Bill Fulcher. An offering was received in the amount of \$29.00. Eric Crabtree offered a beautiful song entitled "Over Shadowed" for our special music. A timely message "The promise of His return" was delivered by Glen Johnson, who read from Revelation 1:7. Prayer of dismissal and giving thanks for noon meal was led by Jennings Dotson.

Friday afternoon session was opened with singing "Power In The Blood." Bruce Brewer conducted devotions reading from Luke 21:28.

The reports of Virginia State Home Mission Board and its Treasurer's Report were given by Walter Statzer. These reports were accepted the following recommendations were adopted:

1. That we work together as a State Association to purchase pews for the West Main Free Will Baptist Church.
2. That we give \$300.00 toward the National Association expenses of the State Home Missionary Willis Osborne.

Report of Virginia State CTS was given by Donna Crabtree and CTS Medals were presented to the following: Benjamin Crabtree (Trumpet), Eric Crabtree (Solo), Jenny Preece (Flute).

The report of the State Promotional Secretary was given by Jeff Crabtree. Motion (tabled 1991) "that the promotional secretary be included in the State Association planning meeting with voting privileges in matters concerning the State Association meeting arrangements" was removed from the table and passed by vote. Article IV of the By-laws is amended by addition of the following: The promotional secretary will attend the State Association planning meeting with voting privileges in matters concerning the State Association meeting

arrangements. Article III, Section VI, number 5 of the By-laws will be changed to: "This board will plan each Bible Conference and State Association meeting along with the Moderator, Clerk, and Promotional Secretary."

General Board member, Jeff Crabtree gave a report which was received as information.

A vote was passed that all reports given as information be received as such.

There was no, "Old Business."

NEW BUSINESS

Executive Board Report: The Board met with Roger Hood from the Greenville Children's Home and he explained to them the change in time that the board members will serve for the Children's Home. A term is for three years with a board member serving a maximum of two terms. The Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists will elect one board member to serve on this board.

Registration Committee Report was given and accepted. Nineteen (19) ministers, two (2) deacons, eleven (11) delegates, and twenty-two (22) visitors were registered.

Treasurer's Report was given by Jack Blanton and accepted by Vote.

The following motions were made and passed by vote of the body:

1. For the Executive Committee to investigate and report back to the next session the possibility of having the Virginia State Association and the CTS competition at the same time, which will necessitate a constitutional change.
2. That the moderators appoint a committee to investigate the financial standing of the Virginia State Association and report its findings to the next session. This committee consisting of Jennings Dotson, Jeff Crabtree, Richard Barnes, and Jack Blanton were appointed by the Moderator.
3. That the Executive Board be empowered to incorporate the Virginia State Association of Free Will Baptists, with the cost of such not to exceed \$600.00.
4. That the mileage rate be set at standard IRS rate for all travel of state representatives for Virginia State work.

5. That the clerk of the Virginia State Association write a letter to the National Executive Secretary with copies to the Directors of each department, and to the Chairman of each board, thanking those who have attended and requesting the Director (or an appointed representative) of that department attend our Virginia State Meeting at least every other year.
